

IMPULSE GENERATOR TEST ARRANGEMENT



Notes:

- 1) The bandwidth capability of components and instruments used to display the impulse generator output signal (attenuators, cables, connectors, etc.) should exceed 1.0 gigahertz.
- 2) The module should be bolted to a heat sink capable of dissipating 7 Watts.
- 3) The use of 60 dB attenuation will insure a peak input signal to the sampling scope of less than one Volt.
- 4) In general, the pulse generator trigger delay control should be set in the 100 ns range. Other settings should be as shown in the above diagram. The impulse generator output is delayed with respect to the trigger input signal by about 70 ns. (typically).
- 5) The impulse generator can withstand an infinite VSWR on the output port.
- 6) The output amplitude may be varied from 150 to 500 Volts using a one turn 1K pot connected between the +15V supply and the front panel "AMP" solder terminal.
